RULES

1. This tournament is open to bowlers from all counties and is sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. The general playing and tournament rules will govern this event together with the following special rules. The tournament is open to all BTBA members . Non members and those unable to produce proof of current BTBA membership may enter upon payment of a £1 fine at registration.

2. Entry fees will be non returnable after the entry has been accepted. However, an entry maybe sold to an eligible replacement. All fees must be enclosed with entry form.

3. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager, Edwin Whitehead, within 20 minutes of the game in which the infraction occurred. The tournament manager reserves the right to reject any entry and his decision on all matters shall be final, subject to an appeal to the B.T.B.A.

4. The tournament will be a handicap event throughout. Bowlers will submit their highest current league or tournament average over 18 games or more. Handicaps will be based on the 75% of the difference between the entering average and 210. Where there is no average over 18 games, bowlers may use their last completed average providing it is no more than 5 pins below their current average over any number of games. Bowlers unable to meet these requirements shall enter with 0 handicap.

5. The entry fee will be £10 which includes £4 prizefund (returned 100%), £0.20 Team England contribution and £0.80 Team Lancashire for adult entries, and £0.50 Junior Team England contribution and £0.50 Junior Lancashire Team contribution for junior entries. £5 from each entry will be donated directly to the Children with Lukemia charity

6. Players must register 10 minutes before their squad time when a lane draw will be held. Late arrivals will commence at the frame in progress.
