

The tournament will not be sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. but their general playing rules will govern this event together with the following special rules:-

This event shall be Scratch throughout.

Format: All bowlers will bowl six games, the top 16 will bowl a further 4 games and the final cut will be for a 6 man Round Robin final.

Any bowler whose conduct is considered to be derogatory to the best interest of the sport on or off the lanes, during the entire period of the tournament, may be disqualified from the tournament.

All players will wear suitable bowling attire. The wearing of denim and shorts (for men) will not be permitted.

Any bowlers arriving late will commence play at the frame in which their lane is on. Any missed frames will be zero.

All competitors must register at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time.

The Tournament Committee shall consist of Ben Hayes as Tournament Manager and Graham Waller as tournament sponsor. Contact Ben on 07801 732626 or e-mail ben.hayes@tenpin-banbury.co.uk. Their decisions on all matters shall be final. A provisional ball will be rolled in the event of any dispute which cannot be resolved immediately. All protests must be lodged verbally with the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the game in which the infraction occurred, and subsequently confirmed in writing within 72 hours.

The Tournament Committee shall not allow any unreasonable delay in the progress of any game. Players failing to make reasonable progress in their games will first be issued with a verbal warning. The second infraction will incur a penalty of the current frame being marked as zero. Subsequent infractions will result in games declared forfeit.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to adjust the prize fund up or down dependant on entries and additional sponsors. They also reserve the right to adjust the number of bowlers or games in the rounds of the finals.

All bowlers are required to use only the ball provided to them by Bowling Vision (Brunswick Avalanche Solid) throughout the tournament, any bowler using more than the ONE BALL provided will be disqualified.

There will be five minutes practice before the first game of each section of qualifying and before the start of the Final.

In the event of a tie for any position during the event, the place will be awarded to the bowler with the highest scratch game.

All scoresheets must be maintained and signed by an opponent from the same pair of lanes (defined where possible as the player playing directly opposite on the same pair) as well as the player. The opposing person signing is responsible for the accuracy of the information recorded. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification from the tournament.

Reaction Characteristics

- Out of the Box:** With its Rough Buff surface the Avalanche Blue/Red Solid with match-up well on medium-dry to medium oily lane conditions.
- If your Avalanche Blue/Red Solid goes too long:** Shiny surface finishes sometimes cause the ball to go too long before breaking. Dull the surface with progressively rougher abrasives to increase hooking action.
- If your Avalanche Blue/Red Solid hooks too early:** Polish the surface with Brunswick's Factory Finish High Gloss Polish. If your Avalanche Blue/Red Solid still hooks too early you will need to use a less aggressive ball, such as Brunswick's Avalanche Blue Pearl / Silver Pearl.
