TOURNAMENT RULES

1. *This is a Team England Ranking Event. The General Playing and Tournament Rules of the B.T.B.A. together with the following special rules shall govern this tournament.*
2. *The tournament is open to all members of the B.T.B.A. who must be in possession of a current B.T.B.A. membership card. Non-production of a card will result in a £1.00 fine.*
3. *All bowlers must be under the age of 18 years as at August 31st 2007.*
4. There will be one division:
5. **Qualification squad, 6 games**
Top 48 will qualify for the final steps, seeded 1-48
Final step 1- 20 players (seeded 29-48) will play 2 games starting from scratch (no match play) Players positioned 1-10 are qualified for the final step 2
Players positioned 11-20 will be ranked 39-48
Final step 2- 20 players (top 10 from the final step 1 and players seeded 19-28) will play 2 games starting from scratch (no match play) Players positioned 1-10 are qualified for the final step 3. Players positioned 11-20 will be ranked 29-38
Final step 3- 20 players (top 10 from the final step 2 and players seeded 9-18) will play 2 games starting from scratch (no match play) Players positioned 1-10 are qualified for the final step 4. Players positioned 11-20 will be ranked 19-28
Final step 4 -18 players (top 10 from the final step 3 and players seeded 1-8 will) play 2 games starting from scratch (no match play) Players positioned 1-8 are qualified for the final step 5. Players positioned 9-18 will be ranked 9-18
Final step 5 - 8 players (top 8 from the final step 4) will play 2 games starting from scratch (no match play) Players positioned 1-4 are qualified for the final step 6. Players positioned 5-8 will be ranked 5-8
Final step 6 - Top 4 from the final step 5 will play 2 semi finals over 1 game
The matches to be combined according to the positions of the top 4 after the final step 5, 1 vs. 4 and 2 vs. 3 The winners of the semi finals are qualified for the final step 7 The losers of the 2 matches will be ranked 3-4 according to their positions after the final step 5
Final step 7 - The winners of the two matches in step 6 will play the final over 1 game The loser of the final will be ranked 2 The winner of the final will be ranked 1
Boys and girls will be mixed girls receiving 8 pins per game bonus. Each round scores revert to zero all rounds are bowled scratch. Finals day is Sunday 15th June.
6. Squads will be mixed in order that Y.B.C's can travel and bowl together a lane draw will be made at registration.
7. The tournament is a scratch tournament, medals are guaranteed for all prize winning positions. Prizes are based on an entry of 250 bowlers and may be adjusted up or down according to the number of entries. Re entries are not permitted.
8. Bowlers from local centres are asked to bowl in early squads. Preference will be given on the last weekend to bowlers travelling more than two hours to the venue.
9. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to bowling. If all bowlers are present and registered then the Management Committee has the right to start the squad early. Tardy players will commence play at the frame in progress as directed by the Tournament Manager

11. Entry fees must accompany the entry form, these to be received with the Tournament Manager no later than 7 (seven) clear days before the date of bowling. Cheques to be made payable to 'AMF Leeds YBC'. Closing date for entries will be 6th June 2008.
12. Competitors who, in the opinion of the Tournament Director are not dressed in correct bowling attire in the playing area will not be permitted to bowl. Shirts must bear the name of a Y.B.C. or the player's name. Sponsors details may be included except for alcohol or tobacco products. Casual shorts, denim clothing or jeans of any description will not be permitted, however, shorts culottes and tailored short trousers may be allowed. Mobile phones should be turned off during match play and are not permitted in the playing area. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the tournament. Profane language, improper gestures or abuse of the bowling equipment or machinery may also result in disqualification. Any disqualification will result in the loss of scores and awards. Any player whose conduct is likely to bring the sport into disrepute will be disqualified from the tournament and reported to the B.T.B.A. for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
13. Only Tournament Officials, Competitors and one licensed Instructor/Coach will be allowed in the player's area during the game. For details of Coaching/Instructing see BTBA rule 333. Coaches and Instructors are required to display their license at all times and also to be dressed in accordance with their position.
14. The Tournament Director is Phill Daggett. He and his Tournament managers reserve the right to re-rate or reject any entry. A provisional ball shall be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests should be made to a Tournament manager within 30 minutes of the end of the game in question and confirmed in writing before the end of the tournament. The Tournament Director's decision is final, subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A.
