

Trials Rules

1. The trials will be B.I.B.A. Sanctioned, and tournament rules will apply to all participants, who must be current members of the B.T.B.A. Failure to produce a valid membership card will result in a £5.00 fine. (Non-members may join upon payment of the annual fee of £25).
2. The trials are open to all members who were born in, or have lived within the Lancashire boundaries (as of 1961 O/S Map) for more than 1 year (serving members of H.M.Forces, and their dependants 6 months).
3. All competitors will bowl 8 (Eight) games moving 1 pairs of lanes after each game (except Juniors who will bowl 6 (Six) games moving 1 pairs of lanes after each game).
4. All competitors must be eligible to hold a British Passport.
5. Only competitors who have bowled in the October/November 2008 trails, and those who qualified for Adult Team England will be considered for the County squads.
6. No denims or shorts are to be worn.
7. Profane language, or abuse of equipment will not be tolerated, and may result in disqualification.
8. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager within 72 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred.
9. The tournament manager's decision on any matter is final, subject to an appeal in writing to the B.T.B.A.
10. The closing date for entries will be midnight 25th October 2008.
11. Registration will be at 9:45am for a 10:30 roll off.
12. No smoking is permitted in the bowling area for the duration of the trials.
- 13 Juniors who wish to be considered for the YAC or Adult squads **MUST** hold a current Junior/Adult BTBA card
- 14 **The Adult Round takes place the 1st weekend in September and Trials entrants should make themselves available for that date.**

Entry Fees

£20.00 : Juniors (inc 50p for Team England)

£28.00 : All other groups (inc 20p for Team England)

Juniors who wish to be considered for the YAC or Adult squads must pay the higher entry fee and *MUST* have a current Junior/Adult BTBA card.

This entitles all entrants to represent any age group (ascending) with the following exceptions:

Senior squad members must be 50 years of age on or before 30th April 2009

YAC squad members must be aged under 24 as at 31st December 2009

Exceptionally, all age groups are eligible for the Adult Squad.

The Junior Squads will consist of:

Under 18's - Top 12 Boys and Top 10 Girls

Under 16's - Top 12 Boys and Top 10 Girls

Under 14's - Top 12 Boys and Top 10 Girls

Wild cards **may** be applied in each Junior age group.

The 2008/9 Junior squads will be selected at the discretion of the team managers, and may include selection of a bowler from a younger age group.

Adult / Senior Squads

The Adult and Senior squads will comprise of 15 bowlers in both the Male and Female sections. Qualifying age for Seniors will be 50 years of age, on or before 30th April 2009.

The three highest scoring competitors in all sections will be offered the option of two games with the County team in 2008/9.

Players in the Senior section will receive 1 pin per year over 50, in accordance with the current B.T.B.A. rules.

In the Adult and Seniors squads, the managers will select the rest of the team from the remaining 12 squad members. Wild cards may be allowed at the discretion of the Managers & Committee. The Y.A.C. Committee will select the 2008/9 Y.A.C. squads.
