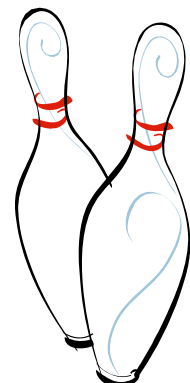
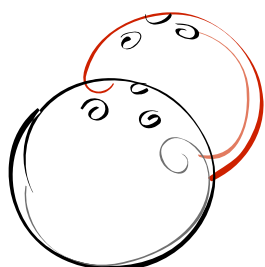

1. This tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and all playing rules will apply, together with the following. All bowlers must produce their BTBA membership card at registration or a £1 fine will be levied. Non-members will not be eligible for BTBA services.
2. The tournament will be singles throughout (bowled at doubles pace). Each bowler will bowl 4 games and be placed in their relevant divisions by age.
3. **Squadding will take place on a first come first served basis and will be allocated by the Tournament Manager after the closing date.**
4. The tournament manager is Billy Gaughan, who reserves the right to reject or re-rate and his decision on all matters shall be final subject to appeal to the BTBA. Protests must be lodged by the YBC official/player within 30 minutes and confirmed in writing before the presentation. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
5. Registration will be 30 mins prior to the squad start time. Bowl off will commence early if all bowlers are present and ready to bowl. Latecomers will commence at the frame in progress.
6. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages at any time during the tournament. Any infringement of this rule will result in immediate disqualification. Inappropriate behaviour including profane language and improper gestures, or abuse of bowling equipment/machinery may also result in disqualification. Any disqualification will result in loss of scores and awards, the bowler will also be reported to the BTBA for consideration for disciplinary procedure.
7. Competitors will wear correct bowling attire in the playing area. Shirts should bear the players name and/or the name of their YBC. Sponsors names may also be included (excluding alcohol and tobacco products). The wearing of hats of any kind will only be permitted at the discretion of the tournament manager. Denim clothing, shorts or cargo style trousers will not be permitted (skorts however, are permitted). Mobile phones, MP3/CD players will not be permitted in the bowling area under any circumstances.
8. Only competitors, tournament officials and one licensed coach will be allowed in the playing area. Officials, instructors and coaches are not permitted to wear casual shorts, denim clothing or jeans of any description. All coaches must display their licence.
9. **The closing date for entries is Friday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2008.**
10. All entry fees **MUST** accompany the fully completed entry form. Telephone/email entries will be held for 10 days and will only be confirmed on receipt of full entry fee. Except in the case of cancellation of the tournament, no entry fees will be refundable after the closing date has passed.
11. The entry fee will be: **£12.00** per bowler (to include Lineage £7.00, Prize fund £3.00 & £2.00 Administration (including NAYBC contribution @ 50p per bowler)). Prize fund will be returned 100%.
12. Please complete the entry form in full. Cheques should accompany the entry form and be made payable to 3D Tournament Account.
